

This non-invasive imaging test allows the doctor to see a wider, more detailed view of the retina than with traditional methods. The image is a permanent part of your medical file which allows the doctor to make important comparisons from year to year. In most cases, there will not be a need to dilate after this imaging. If the doctor decides there is still a need for dilation, it will be discussed during your exam.

These images may detect early signs of many ocular conditions & systemic diseases including:

- Retinal holes, detachment, or tumors
- Glaucoma
- Macular Degeneration
- High Blood Pressure
- Diabetes
